Officer's Gave the Following Reports



Chatelaine: Lady Caran DeBurg Present

- 12 boxes of fabric still available to distribute, possibly host an exchange of some kind
 - Sinn suggested Lady Caran take photos of the inventory so we all know what we have



Exchequer: Lady Thorve of Highland Foorde Present

- \$12,698.43 in Baronage account.
- Followed up on 2 checks we sent last HRM. One was bounced, the other was never cashed.
- Looked into Wells Fargo, only need to have \$1,000 in the account to avoid fees instead of \$7,500
- Took 201 and learned that we don't have to stay with Wells Fargo. They are willing to examine other banks as long as they are willing to work with the needs of the SCA
 - Thorve will talk to Wells Fargo to see

- if we can get an interest account wit a low maintaining balance. If they say no, she will begin looking into other options.
- Sinn asked about current signers on the accounts
 - Thorve mentions that there are way too many signers on the account.
 Man old officers need to be removed and Jeff still needs to be added on.

- Recent Seneschal meeting takeaways:
 - For Baronial courts, you can have it in a separate zoom without it being a second event
 - Kingdom of Atlantia is looking for volunteers for social media and a Diversity and Inclusion officer

- Regarding opening the kingdom, offical fighter practices are still disallowed, but they obviously can't control what private citizens do
- However, the kingdom will shut down groups individually based on their areas infection rate as reported by the CDC.
- There is still some confusion on what makes a digital court official, but they are still ironing that out.
 Still waiting on in-writing guidance on virtual events from the Kingdom level.
- Crown will be happening in person, causing a delay for the next University

Old Business

- HRM: Sinn has not heard from Mark.
- Should we host HRM later?Leave it at the date it's at and if it gets canceled it gets canceled?
 - Scandal we have lost our traditional date. This is our opportunity to move it to any other date we wanted. HRM might be a more successful event if we made it earlier/later when it isn't as hot (site provides little to no shade)
 - Caran will also try to get ahold of Mark
- Highland Havoc: Currently ongoing virtually!
 - 3 new challenges have been added, bringing us to 16 total.
 - Sinn Kate Newton may help be one of the judges
 - Challenge deadlines will not be extended due to the nature of the events
- Feast equipment fundraising
 - Was brought up at a meeting some time ago by Caran. Scandal wanted to revisit the idea.
 - Some sort of food delivery program to raise funds. Might be more successful now versus later, especially with Covid still occuring
 - Thorve and Viljamaier are in charge of finding out what needs to be done at the group level so we can present a proposal
 - Epy has experience with SCA Equestrian fundraising, may be able to help as well.
 - Maybe have a Baronial Officer for fundraising (along the same lines as a Quartermaster)

 On the topic of fundraising: do a traveling fund in the future for Baronage? currently there, email the Webminister

New Business

- Dedicated Aliases/Officer Emails
 - Lots of duplicate emails that aren't needed
 - Asking Jeff to provide a list of email addresses we actually need to cut down on the bulk
 - All emails with 'hf' in the front are being deleted
 - No need for the dash in 'highlandfoorde' so changes are coming
 - Event specific emails are created that are being forwarded to other addresses
 - Consider having a gmail address for those events or have a hosted email address (no need for both)
 - SCA is not going to GSuites, but we as a Barony can move forward with utilizing Google at a base level
 - Will have more continuity when changing hands leadership wise and just making it easier for autocrats/officers to pass along information
 - Updating the Baronage emails to become gender neutral.
 - Will change the email to baronage@...
 - Auto replies will also be set up as well
- New Website
 - Still doesn't actually exist. Have read the handbook on what the website needs to be policy wise and both versions of the website go against those policies.
