

The role of the KM is to make fighting safer, and therefore, more fun for everyone. As a warranted officer, the KM is a direct representative of the Crown, and a legal representative of the SCA.

Instead of using Discord for the A&S meetings, can we use Google Meet instead? It will not be rolled out before Pennsic but afterwards. In the winter we would like to have a picnic for a holiday gathering such a potluck which could select champions. Can we re-institute this idea? For one of the monthly classes we would like their to be a feast class for pre-Hearthglow ceremonies.

The SCA Board of Directors approved to have a rapier crown tournament during the next calendar year for the East Kingdom. There could be no other variances for any kingdom for at least one more calendar year, but this will be a new way of selecting SCA leaders in the future-depending on how it works. This will be a test to see if other variances can be successful as well. We are getting ready for Pennsic and we hope to see as many members of the populace that can make during our open house or whenever you feel like.

Recurring Business

1. Highland Havoc

Epy officially voted in as event steward for Highland Havoc! They will work with the seneschal to get an event steward warrant. Thank you to Scandal for creating a website and thank you to Svana for publishing the A&S activities. If anyone wants to teach or volunteer then you can fill out a form on the website or get in touch with the coordinators in charge. No thrown weapons marshals have volunteered as of yet, but we would like to do that activity if possible. Everything is on schedule and insurance will be ordered before the end of September. If you want to pre-registers then you can do so on SCORES.

2. Highland River Melees

No autocrat or event site confirmed but some ideas for sites further west in the barony could work. However we need scouts to search to see if anything is suitable. This will be revisited next meeting.

3. HF Picnic

No new developments at this time, but please send any suggestions for dates/locations! It may end up after Pennsic this year out of necessity. This will be discussed for next meeting.

4. Highland Hearthglow

An event steward request was put in by Scandal and they were approved by populace to be the official event steward. An updated event budget was sent out to see if anyone wanted to ask questions. Estimated expense for \$4339 is being asked for to run the event. 2 abstentions and 5 aye's which passes. Expected menu is posted and website conitnues to be updated. A schedule will be issued after Pennsic.

5. HF Banner Project

On hold until after Pennsic and Renn Faire.

6. Baronial Dayshade Replacement

An upper limit budget is being set and this will be discussed after Pennsic. This will most likely occur during an emergency financial committee meeting. Eadric would have more information about this subject. After this meeting, during Pennsic, an emergency meeting will most likely be called by the seneschal. This can also occur during opening procession.

7. Baronial @home Tabled until the next meeting.

8. Baronial Feast Equipment

Serving ware is being bought new by manufacturer. However, the cookware was sourced by a different website and the cost was to high. So Scandal found another wholesaler which had a more reasonable price. We could also consider buying equipment from auctions. Scandal has won some items from auctions in an effort to lower the cost for the barony. ~\$3000 is the current estimated price for the new cookware and estimated storage costs, which would be paid back through the possible profit for Hearthglow. Svana wants to know how much money is necessary for the barony to maintain stability in order to afford new things. Currently the barony is doing well for finances and there is no site fee for Hearthglow which means there is little to lose. The baronage is currently looking for new storage units to store this new equipment if possible. The cost is necessary to store all of the baronies items instead of it staying in individuals homes. A trailer is also an option on the table. If a trailer is bought then a tag would have to be bought, which would require registration under the baronies identity. The barony needs to prepare for a total outlay of ~\$3000 and agree to store equipment in a location that does not currently exist. Serving-ware will be voted on next month. A motion is being put forward to ask for \$750.00 to allow for Scandal to purchase additional auctions. Motion passes with 7 aye's. This will be further discussed in an emergency financial meeting.

9. LEAFS

Epy hopes to run this in coordination with Mia Mousetower of Storvik. An event steward warrant needs for Epy and is approved with 8 aye's. Epy is soliciting for teachers with the new volunteer form on the new website. There is excitement for agricultural classes and the same with forestry but they need coordinators.

10. Baronial Officer Replacements: Knight Marshal (ad created), Youth Officer, and Quartermaster needed. A herald has been selected.





Award Submission Guide

The best time to submit an award recommendation is now! Your friends, family, and even distant acquaintances have likely done some work that is should be recognized by all. This small guide will help streamline the process and take out any guess work and help get people recognition that they have earned!

This guide is to help everyone, new and old alike, navigate the <u>Award Recommendation</u> <u>System (ARS)</u> and get those awards submitted for your Baronage and Their Royal Majesties to see.

Welcome to the

Step 1: Log in

In order to access the ARS, you must have a log in. ARS uses Atlantian Enterprise Login (AEL) so if you've ever signed in for the University of Atlantia, Orders of the Laurel, Pelican, Pearl, or Golden Dolphin – you're ready to go! There is a chance you'll still need to connect your account with your SCA membership but that's super easy, you just type in your account number. For this process, I have logged in as myself. Here is what your screen should look like:


Step 2: Enter their name

This is to help find their entry in th Order of Precedence (OP). Why is this important? Some people have very similar names, some may have changed their name. All in all, it's to help make sure you are selecting the right person to get the right award. That could be awkward.

This initial page is a search to see if the individual is already in the Order of Precedence, you may enter any of the three names or any part of the names if you are not sure of spelling. Step 3: What did they do?


So you've found your person, great! This is when you get to tell Their Excellencies or Their Royal Majesties what awesome thing they did to deserve their award. When you select the award, It will give a brief description of the qualifications one would reach to earn it. As you can see, you have a ton of space to tell of their deeds, so splurge away!



Step 4: Where are they?

If you've ever attended court, you know that all levels of royalty love to surprise those who are receiving awards. But get ready for awkward moment #2: they aren't around. How awful would that be? In this section of the recommendation, if you know of events the recipient is going to attend, you can mark them here! But only mark it if you're sure they will be there. Of course things happen and plans change, but you can't help that. However, if you know ahead of time that they can't go to an event anymore, you can always change it after the fact. Once you're done, just hit submit!

Here is what this page will look like if you've filled in events.






Step 5: So you've made a mistake...

No worries! Luckily, you can go back and update your recommendation. For this lucky recipient, I've blocked out the good deeds they've done. But you can see that it will date your recommendation so you know when you wrote it!

Don't forget that whenever you're done, you need to save.



Step 6: The waiting game

Congratulations! If you've made it this far, you have successfully submitted your very first award! Now you have spread one's good deeds to Their Excellencies and Their Royal Majesties to review. But when will they get said award? Who knows! Awards aren't guaranteed and there is no timeline for when they get announced. Plus, there is scribal work and illumination. It takes some time.
